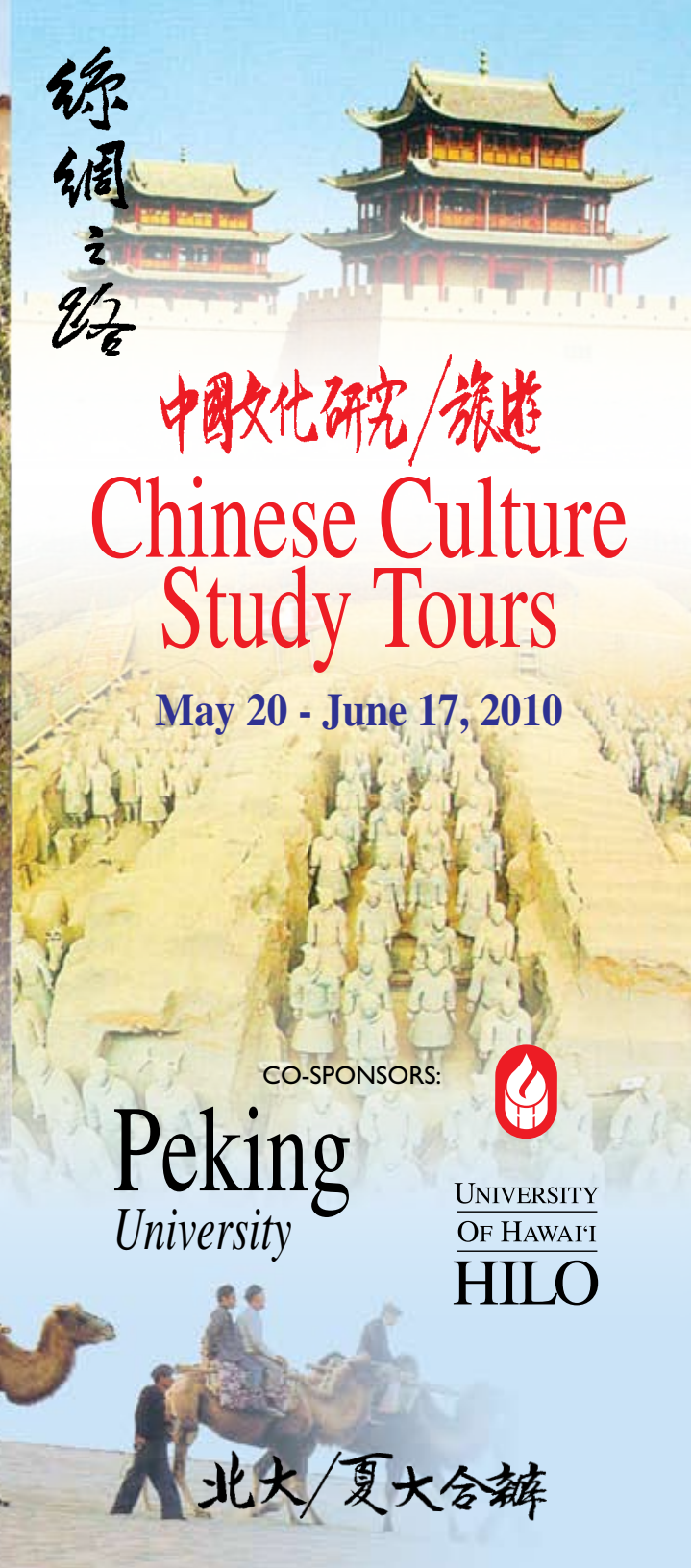

## Summer 2010 at Peking University and Chinese Culture Study Tour

For the 23rd time, the University of Hawai'i at Hilo and Peking University, the most prestigious institution of higher education in China, will co-sponsor the Summer Institute in Chinese Thought and Chinese Culture. The program will include lectures on Chinese culture as well as field trips to various historical sites, cultural centers, scenic spots and business places in China.

Peking University will grant 2 credits and issue a certificate. Participants will also obtain 4 undergraduate credits from UH Hilo, and the credits can be used to satisfy one UH English "writing intensive" requirement. Graduate students may register for 3 graduate credits. Auditors are welcome.

**Tentative Cost:** \$4,295 (undergraduate students with credits)  
 \$4,283 (graduate students with credits)  
 \$3,449 (without UHH credits)

### Tentative Itinerary:

USA--Beijing(stay at Peking University, & tour major historical sites & cultural centers around Beijing)--Jiayuguan (the major pass of the Silk Road)--Dunjuang (the world famous grottoes, the largest living art museum in the world)--Lanzhou (heart of China)--Hecho (the Tibetan village)--Jiuzhaigou (China's Eden)--Huangrong (China's paradise)--Xian (ancient capital of China, famous terracotta soldiers & Daching Christian Monument)--Shanghai (the commercial center of modern China)--USA.

The cost includes: 1) train, bus, boat, and air fares in China, 2) major field trips and entrance fees, 3) tuition & lecture fees, 4) room (double occupancy) and major meals outside Beijing, 5) registration, institute and administration fees, 6) service and tips.
